Northwest Health and Wellness Campus

Premier Health has partnered with the YMCA of Dayton, Wright State University, the Homeownership Center of Dayton, CountyCorp, CareSource, Goodwill and the United Way to build a Health and Wellness campus in Northwest Dayton. Responding to a community driven planning and vision process organized by PhoenixNext the campus offerings will address two central themes articulated by residents: physical development that supports health, wellness and next generation learning opportunities.

The partners will construct a 50,000 sq. ft. facility on the former Good Samaritan Hospital site located at the corner of Salem Avenue and Philadelphia Drive. The Northwest Health and Wellness campus is a major catalytic project that will leverage public and private investments underway in Northwest Dayton. The project will support healthy lifestyles through the addition of Premier Health medical services including an Urgent Care center and a full-service YMCA. As the first build on the former GSH campus site, it will add a new amenity to Northwest Dayton. In addition, the other partners in this project will offer services that create positive economic opportunities such as job training, advanced education options, homebuyer training and financial literacy programs.
